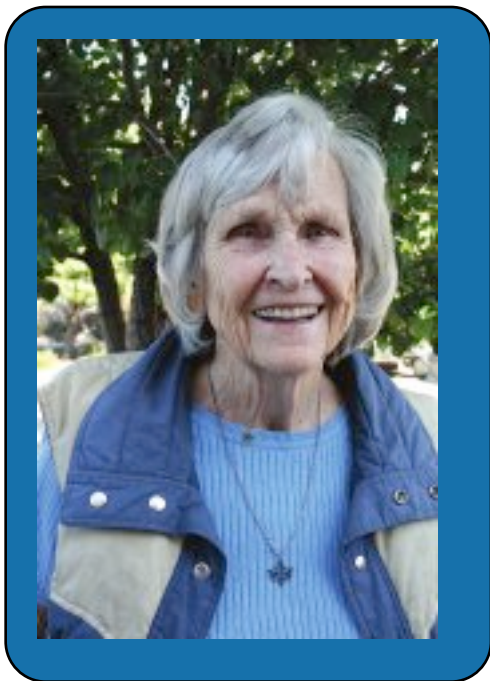

### Meet Joyce Bilgrave

Mrs. Bilgrave's four decades of academic and camp experience span the United States. She is cofounder and former director of the Jemicy School of Baltimore, Maryland, a nationally acclaimed program of excellence for dyslexic students. She cofounded and directed Camp Bombadil, a day camp for dyslexic students, and Big Rock Creek Camp, a conference center and outdoor science program in the Angeles National Forest of Southern California. In addition, Mrs. Bilgrave was instrumental in founding the following schools for dyslexic children: Rawson-Saunders School, Austin, Texas; Durango Mountain Camp; and the Liberty School in Durango, Colorado.

Mrs Bilgrave is currently teaching the Orton Gillingham method. Additionally, she is starting a summer day camp program in the Denver/Evergreen area for students with reading issues and dyslexia.
