This 2-day session is the initial stage of Key Three training and covers the following topics:

- An overview of comprehension strategies, including factors that can affect comprehension
- How to teach three key skills: identifying main ideas, taking notes, and summarizing
- How to incorporate these skills into before, during and after activities including main idea topic webs, questions generated from main ideas, and oral/written summaries
- Practice activities using the teacher's classroom reading material
- Suggestions for implementing the Key Three Routine in classrooms and on a school-wide basis



Please bring student content reading materials from your classroom to practice and develop comprehension and study strategies.

Professional Development Plan:

The professional development program for Key Three in schools includes these stages:

- Initial 2-day training for teachers/administrators who will be using the program
- 2-day training for building-based coaches who will facilitate implementation and provide support to teachers
- 3 on-site follow up days by a certified Key Three trainer to conduct small-group meetings

The goal is for the Key Three trainer to turn over support for implementation of the program to the school.
